



Hall of Fame Criteria

Approved by the Squash PEI executive, Oct 18, 2006.

- Description:** The Squash PEI Hall of Fame is a web-based archive which formally recognizes, and celebrates the squash-related achievements and contributions of its inductees. Members can be inducted into the Hall of Fame in either of two categories: (1) Player; (2) Builder.
- Eligibility:** To be considered for induction into the Hall of Fame, the person must be nominated, in writing, by a current member of Squash PEI. Nominations will normally only be accepted by the Squash PEI executive if the nominee meets or exceeds the following minimum criteria.
- Player Category:
1. Recognized by the Squash PEI ranking system as the top "A" division player for at least three years
 2. Recognized success as a competitor at regional or national events
- Builder Category:
1. Recognized long-term commitment as a volunteer in support of the Squash PEI mandates, and/or a significant contribution to the promotion and development of squash infrastructure in PEI.
- Rationale:** Squash PEI seeks to enshrine a sense of history and to honour those individuals who have contributed greatly to the Island squash community.
- Selection Body :** Selection of Nominee Roster: Squash PEI executive.
Selection of Inductees form the Nomination roster: Squash PEI membership.
- Selection Process:** Each year, the Executive will solicit (normally in the Fall) from its membership nomination letters for Hall of Fame candidates. The nomination letter must include the name of the nominee, nominator, nomination category (Player or Builder) and document the accomplishments/contributions which are to be considered in the initial

selection process by the Squash PEI Executive. The Executive may supplement the nomination material as it sees fit.

The executive will decide inclusion or not into the Nomination Roster by a secret, simple majority, vote proctored by the Squash PEI secretary. Once the current year's Nomination Roster has been established, the Executive will publish the Nomination Roster and the supporting material for each candidate, and in due course administer a vote by the membership. The membership will be asked to vote "yes" or "no" to each of the candidates' suitability for induction into the Hall of Fame. Induction into the Hall of Fame will require votes cast by at least 65% of all registered members of Squash PEI (at the time of the vote), of which, at least 80% must be "yes" votes. The decision will be reported to the candidate by the Squash PEI secretary. Formal acknowledgment of induction into the Hall of Fame will be made by presentation at the Squash PEI AGM.
